The position involves general administration duties such as printing the weekly newsletter, preparation for the weekend Masses, telephone duties as well as other general administration duties.

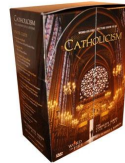
The team at St Mary's Parish values a friendly and supportive work atmosphere and will provide training to the successful applicant.
